

SENATE BILL NO. 368—SENATOR AMODEI

MARCH 16, 2001

Referred to Committee on Finance

SUMMARY—Makes appropriation to Carson City for establishment of housing in Carson City for persons returning to community from institutional care. (BDR S-1207)

AN ACT making an appropriation to Carson City for the establishment of housing in Carson City for persons returning to the community from institutional care; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

1 WHEREAS, The State of Nevada values all residents for their many
2 contributions to this state; and

3 WHEREAS, It is a priority of the State of Nevada that all residents lead
4 the most productive lives possible; and

5 WHEREAS, One of the most important steps in supporting
6 disenfranchised persons is to ensure that appropriate housing and support
7 are available; and

8 WHEREAS, The transition into a community is extremely difficult for
9 those persons who have required residential care; and

10 WHEREAS, Residents of Carson City and Douglas, Lyon, Storey and
11 Churchill counties have limited resources and to date have not been able to
12 provide adequate transitional housing for such persons who desire to
13 become productive members of their communities; now, therefore,

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15 THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN
16 SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

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18 **Section 1.** There is hereby appropriated from the state general fund to
19 Carson City the sum of \$350,000 for the establishment of housing in
20 Carson City for persons returning to the community from institutional care.

21 **Sec. 2.** Any remaining balance of the appropriation made by section 1
22 of this act must not be committed for expenditure after June 30, 2003, and
23 reverts to the state general fund as soon as all payments of money
24 committed have been made.
