AN ACT relating to education; authorizing the Department of Education to spend from the state distributive school account money for grants to school libraries for purposes relating to educational technology; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. 1. The Department of Education is hereby authorized to spend from the state distributive school account for the Commission on Educational Technology to grant money to school libraries for the acquisition of licenses to access research databases and other on-line resources appropriate for pupils, the sum of \$500,000 for the 2001-2002 fiscal year.

2. Any remaining balance of the sum authorized for expenditure pursuant to subsection 1 must not be committed for expenditure after June 30, 2002, and reverts to the state distributive school account as soon as all payments of money committed have been made.

**Sec. 2.** This act becomes effective on July 1, 2001.
