AN ACT relating to health care; enacting the Frontier and Rural Health Care Improvement Act of 2001; making appropriations for certain medical services, training and equipment; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. This act may be cited as the Frontier and Rural Health Care
Improvement Act of 2001.
Sec. 2. The legislature hereby finds and declares that the Frontier and

Rural Health Care Improvement Act of 2001 is intended to address important issues and concerns affecting the health care needs of rural Nevadans by supporting the education and training of health care providers, and focusing upon special population needs and the delivery of health care services.

Sec. 3. 1. There is hereby appropriated from the state general fund to the Northeastern Nevada Area Health Education Center for expenses related to the establishment of an Emergency Medical Services Training Academy through the Northeastern Nevada Area Health Education Center and the Great Basin Community College to address on-site, distance education and Internet-based programming for continuous education and training for all levels of emergency medical services personnel, including emergency medical services management and administration:

2. There is hereby appropriated from the state general fund to the Northeastern Nevada Area Health Education Center for the purchase and



distribution throughout the state of automatic external defibrillators through the Emergency Medical Services Training Academy:

University and Community College System of Nevada for costs relating to the establishment of a Physician Assistant Training Program through the University of Nevada School of Medicine with 50 percent of the training positions providing clinical services to medically underserved areas for a 2year period:

For the fiscal year 2001-2002......\$152,315 For the fiscal year 2002-2003......\$282,477

4. There is hereby appropriated from the state general fund to the Rural Clinics Administration Office of the Division of Mental Health and Developmental Services of the Department of Human Resources for the establishment of a rural mental health telemedicine network within the State of Nevada rural mental health centers to provide continuity and emergency access to mental health services:

There is hereby appropriated from the state general fund to the Health Division of the Department of Human Resources for the enhancement of the delivery of perinatal health care services with the support of obstetrical nurse practitioners linked to a developed network of rural and urban physicians and facilities to address routine and emergency patient care needs:

For the fiscal year 2001-2002......\$111,480

University and Community College System of Nevada for the University of Nevada School of Medicine to expand the Nevada Health Service Corps loan repayment program to target health care professionals of which there is a critical shortage, including emergency medical services personnel, dentists, dental hygienists and nurses:

For the fiscal year 2001-2002......\$70,000 For the fiscal year 2002-2003......\$140,000

- 7. There is hereby appropriated from the state general fund to the University and Community College System of Nevada for the Office of Rural Health of the University of Nevada School of Medicine the sum of \$500,000 for the establishment of a Capital Loan Pool to provide financial access to rural health care facilities and practitioners for durable medical equipment, facility renovation costs and other equipment to address health care service needs.
- There is hereby appropriated from the state general fund to the Division of Health Care Financing and Policy of the Department of Human Resources to pay the costs of an incremental adjustment in Medicaid reimbursement for rural primary health care practitioners in general practice, family practice, internal medicine, pediatrics, obstetrics and gynecology and for rural dentists, physician assistants and advanced

5	Sec. 4. Any remaining balance of the appropriations made by section
