AN ACT relating to the Department of Motor Vehicles and Public Safety; requiring the Department to enter into certain interlocal contracts to provide services for the registration of motor vehicles in Boulder City and in and around Overton; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- **Section 1.** 1. The Director of the Department of Motor Vehicles and Public Safety shall, upon the agreement of all parties, enter into an interlocal contract pursuant to NRS 277.180 with:
- (a) The City Council of Boulder City, Nevada, to provide services in Boulder City for the registration of motor vehicles.
- 6 (b) The Board of County Commissioners of Clark County to provide 7 services in and around Overton, Nevada, for the registration of motor 8 vehicles.
  - 2. The department shall enter into negotiations for such contracts as soon as practicable after the effective date of this act.
    - Sec. 2. This act becomes effective upon passage and approval.
