AN ACT making an appropriation to the Administrator of the Courts of the Second Judicial District for the continuation of its programs of treatment for the abuse of alcohol or drugs; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. There is hereby appropriated from the state general fund to the Administrator of the Courts of the Second Judicial District of the State of Nevada the sum of \$330,000 for the continuation of its programs of treatment for the abuse of alcohol or drugs by certain persons that are supervised by a judge in the Second Judicial District.

6 Sec. 2. Any remaining balance of the appropriation made by section 1 of this act must not be committed for expenditure after June 30, 2003, and 8 reverts to the state general fund as soon as all payments of money committed have been made.

10 **Sec. 3.** This act becomes effective upon passage and approval.
