THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN  
SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1     **Section 1.** There is hereby appropriated from the state general fund to  
2     the Department of Human Resources the sum of \$163,524 for new and  
3     replacement equipment and computer hardware and software at the Rural  
4     Clinics to be distributed as follows:  
5         1. For equipment ..... \$154,644  
6         2. For operating expenses for fiscal year 2001-2002 ..... \$4,440  
7         3. For operating expenses for fiscal year 2002-2003 ..... \$4,440  
8     **Sec. 2.** 1. Any remaining balance of the appropriation made by  
9     subsection 1 of section 1 of this act must not be committed for expenditure  
10    after June 30, 2003, and reverts to the state general fund as soon as all  
11    payments of money committed have been made.  
12         2. Any remaining balance of the appropriation made by subsection 2 of  
13    section 1 of this act must not be committed for expenditure after June 30,  
14    2002, and reverts to the state general fund as soon as all payments of  
15    money committed have been made.  
16         3. Any remaining balance of the appropriation made by subsection 3 of  
17    section 1 of this act must not be committed for expenditure after June 30,  
18    2003, and reverts to the state general fund as soon as all payments of  
19    money committed have been made.
