AN ACT making an appropriation to the Department of Human Resources for marketing efforts and enhancement of subsidies for the provision of prescription drugs and pharmaceutical services to senior citizens; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN  
SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1 **Section 1.** There is hereby appropriated from the state general fund to
- 2 the Department of Human Resources the sum of \$1,000,000 for marketing
- 3 efforts and enhancement of subsidies for the provision of prescription
- 4 drugs and pharmaceutical services to senior citizens.
- 5 **Sec. 2.** Any remaining balance of the appropriation made by section 1
- 6 of this act must not be committed for expenditure after June 30, 2003, and
- 7 reverts to the state general fund as soon as all payments of money
- 8 committed have been made.
- 9 **Sec. 3.** This act becomes effective upon passage and approval.
