AN ACT making an appropriation to the Nevada Silver Haired Legislative Forum of the Aging Services Division of the Department of Human Resources; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN
SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1 **Section 1.** 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Nevada Silver
2 Haired Legislative Forum of the Aging Services Division of the
3 Department of Human Resources the sum of \$5,000.
4 2. Upon acceptance of the money appropriated by subsection 1, the
5 Nevada Silver Haired Legislative Forum of the Aging Services Division of
6 the Department of Human Resources agrees to:
7 (a) Prepare and transmit a report to the Interim Finance Committee on
8 or before December 15, 2002, that describes each expenditure made from
9 the money appropriated by subsection 1 from the date on which the money
10 was received by the Nevada Silver Haired Legislative Forum through
11 December 1, 2002; and
12 (b) Upon request of the Legislative Commission, make available to the
13 Legislative Auditor any books, accounts, claims, reports, vouchers or other
14 records of information, confidential or otherwise and irrespective of their
15 form or location, that the Legislative Auditor deems necessary to conduct
16 any audit of the use of the money appropriated pursuant to subsection 1.
17 **Sec. 2.** Any remaining balance of the appropriation made by section 1
18 of this act must not be committed for expenditure after June 30, 2003, and
19 reverts to the state general fund as soon as all payments of money
20 committed have been made.
