AN ACT relating to health care; requiring the Center for Business and Economic Research at the University of Nevada, Las Vegas, to publish a report relating to health care services for children who are not covered by health insurance; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- **Section 1.** 1. The Center for Business and Economic Research at the University of Nevada, Las Vegas, shall compile information relating to the provision of health care services for children in this state who are not covered by health insurance and publish a report entitled *Kids Count Databook*. The report must include:
- (a) The name of each program that provides health care services to children in this state and the number of children the program serves each year;
- 9 (b) The number of children in this state who are eligible to receive 10 health care services from each program;
- 11 (c) The number of children who are eligible for, but do not receive 12 health care services, from each program; and
 - (d) Any other information the Center for Business and Economic Research determines is appropriate.
