SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1 **Section 1.** Notwithstanding the provisions of NRS 354.723, chapter
2 265, Statutes of Nevada 1971, at page 384, and all amendments made
3 thereto, is hereby repealed.
4 **Sec. 2.** This act becomes effective upon passage and approval.
