AN ACT relating to legislative affairs; requiring the Legislative Auditor to contract with a private auditing or consulting firm to conduct an audit of the Emission Reduction Credit Program in Clark County; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

**Section 1.** 1. The Legislative Auditor shall contract through a sole source contract with a private auditing or consulting firm to conduct an audit of the Emission Reduction Credit Program in Clark County.

2. The contract must require the private auditing or consulting firm to complete the audit and to submit a final written report of the audit to the Legislative Auditor not later than May 31, 2001. The Legislative Auditor shall submit copies of the final written report of the audit to the members of the Senate Committee on Legislative Affairs and Operations, to the members of the Audit Subcommittee of the Legislative Commission and to the District Attorney of Clark County.

**Sec. 2.** 1. Upon the request of the Legislative Auditor, the Clark County Health District shall transfer to the legislative fund the sum of \$200,000 to carry out the provisions of section 1 of this act.

2. Any remaining balance of the sum transferred pursuant to subsection 1 must not be committed for expenditure after May 31, 2001, and must be transferred to the Clark County Health District as soon as all payments of money have been made.



- Sec. 3. The provisions of subsection 1 of NRS 354.599 do not apply to any additional expenses of a local government that are related to the provisions of this act.

  Sec. 4. This act becomes effective on passage and approval.
