AN ACT making an appropriation to the Department of Motor Vehicles for wiring and modular furniture for the Las Vegas Highway Patrol facility; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. There is hereby appropriated from the state highway fund to the Department of Motor Vehicles and Public Safety the sum of \$969,592 for wiring and modular furniture for the Las Vegas Highway Patrol facility.

Sec. 2. Any remaining balance of the appropriation made by section 1 of this act must not be committed for expenditure after June 30, 2003, and reverts to the state highway fund as soon as all payments of money committed have been made.

Sec. 3. This act becomes effective upon passage and approval.
