AN ACT making appropriations to the Opportunity Village Foundation for the revitalization of certain thrift stores and to the Washoe Association for Retarded Citizens for creation of a pilot program to develop an employment model and reimbursement model; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN
SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1 **Section 1.** 1. There is hereby appropriated from the state general
2 fund to Opportunity Village Foundation the sum of \$200,000 for the
3 revitalization of the thrift stores that are operated by the Opportunity
4 Village Foundation.
5 2. Upon acceptance of the money appropriated by subsection 1, the
6 Opportunity Village Foundation agrees to:
7 (a) Prepare and transmit a report to the Interim Finance Committee on
8 or before December 15, 2002, that describes each expenditure made from
9 the money appropriated by subsection 1 from the date on which the money
10 was received by the Opportunity Village Foundation through December 1,
11 2002; and
12 (b) Upon request of the Legislative Commission, make available to the
13 Legislative Auditor any books, accounts, claims, reports, vouchers or other
14 records of information, confidential or otherwise and irrespective of their
15 form or location, that the Legislative Auditor deems necessary to conduct
16 any audit of the use of the money appropriated pursuant to subsection 1.
17 **Sec. 2.** 1. There is hereby appropriated from the state general fund
18 to Washoe Association for Retarded Citizens the sum of \$50,000 for
19 creation of a pilot program to develop supportive employment and



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1 reimbursement models to assist clients in their efforts to find and maintain
2 meaningful, productive employment.

3 2. Upon acceptance of the money appropriated by subsection 1, the
4 Washoe Association for Retarded Citizens agrees to:

5 (a) Prepare and transmit a report to the Interim Finance Committee on
6 or before December 15, 2002, that describes each expenditure made from
7 the money appropriated by subsection 1 from the date on which the money
8 was received by the Washoe Association for Retarded Citizens through
9 December 1, 2002; and

10 (b) Upon request of the Legislative Commission, make available to the
11 Legislative Auditor any books, accounts, claims, reports, vouchers or other
12 records of information, confidential or otherwise and irrespective of their
13 form or location, that the Legislative Auditor deems necessary to conduct
14 any audit of the use of the money appropriated pursuant to subsection 1.

15 **Sec. 3.** Any remaining balance of the appropriation made by sections
16 1 and 2 of this act must not be committed for expenditure after June 30,
17 2003, and reverts to the state general fund as soon as all payments of
18 money committed have been made.

19 **Sec. 4.** This act becomes effective upon passage and approval.
