SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1 **Section 1.** Section 26 of chapter 535, Statutes of Nevada 1999, at
2 page 2750, is hereby amended to read as follows:

4 a.m. on October 1, 1999.
5 ~~12. Section 5.5 of this act expires by limitation on June 30, 2001.~~
6 **Sec. 2.** This act becomes effective upon passage and approval.
