AN ACT relating to the public utilities commission of Nevada; revising provisions governing certain education and informational services provided by the commission; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. NRS 704.961 is hereby amended to read as follows: 704.961 The commission shall expend [up to \$500,000] such money as it determines appropriate from its reserve account to provide education and informational services necessary to educate and inform the residents [in] of this state on issues related to the provision of energy in this state, including, without limitation, the provision of competitive utility services [in this state. The commission shall contract with an independent person to provide such educational and informational services.] and the conservation of energy.
