SUMMARY—Revises provisions governing issuance of replacement license plates. (BDR S-1223)

AN ACT relating to motor vehicles; extending the reversion date of an appropriation made in the previous session for the production of certain license plates; requiring the Department of Motor Vehicles and Public Safety to complete the replacement of the bighorn sheep license plates within a specified period; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN
SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1 **Section 1.** Section 2 of chapter 609, Statutes of Nevada 1999, at page
2 3327, is hereby amended to read as follows:
3 Sec. 2. Any remaining balance of the appropriation made by
4 section 1 of this act must not be committed for expenditure after
5 June 30, ~~2001~~, **2003**, and reverts to the state highway fund as soon
6 as all payments of money committed have been made.
7 **Sec. 2.** The Department of Motor Vehicles and Public Safety shall, on
8 or before December 31, 2002, and upon payment of all applicable
9 registration fees and motor vehicle privilege taxes, replace all previously
10 issued bighorn sheep license plates:
11 1. With the redesigned license plates issued pursuant to NRS 482.270
12 as that section existed on July 1, 1999; or
13 2. Upon request of the registrant and payment of any additional
14 licensing fees, with any other type of license plate for which the registrant
15 is eligible.
16 **Sec. 3.** This act becomes effective upon passage and approval.
