THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN  
SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1     **Section 1.** NRS 218.230 is hereby amended to read as follows:  
2     218.230 1. Except as otherwise provided in this section, there must  
3     be paid to the employees of the senate and assembly, for all services  
4     rendered by them under the provisions of this chapter, the following ~~sums~~  
5     *base amounts* of money for each day's employment ~~and no more:~~

28	2. <i>In addition to the positions listed in subsection 1, the secretary of</i>	
29	<i>the senate and the chief clerk of the assembly may establish additional</i>	
30	<i>positions as necessary and shall establish an appropriate base amount</i>	
31	<i>for those additional positions.</i>	
32	3. <i>The base amount paid to an employee of the legislature listed in</i>	
33	<i>subsection 1 or created pursuant to subsection 2:</i>	
34	(a) <i>Must be increased cumulatively by each cost of living increase</i>	
35	<i>granted to employees in the classified service of the state that becomes</i>	
36	<i>effective on or after July 1, 2001; and</i>	
37	(b) <i>May be increased cumulatively by the secretary of the senate or the</i>	
38	<i>chief clerk of the assembly, as applicable, by one step of 5 percent for</i>	
39	<i>each regular legislative session during which the employee previously</i>	
40	<i>worked for the legislature in the same or a similar position, not to exceed</i>	
41	<i>nine steps per position, if the secretary of the senate or the chief clerk of</i>	
42	<i>the assembly determined that the employee performed his duties in a</i>	
43	<i>satisfactory manner during the previous session or sessions.</i>	
44	4. <i>During periods of adjournment to a day certain, employees of the</i>	
45	<i>legislature whose service is required shall perform duties as assigned and</i>	
46	<i>are entitled to be paid the base amount specified in subsection 1 for each</i>	
47	<i>day of service</i> <del>†</del>	
48	<del>3.†</del> , <i>as adjusted pursuant to subsection 3, if applicable.</i>	



1       5. During periods before the commencement of a session and after the  
2 adjournment of a session sine die, employees of the legislature whose  
3 service is required shall perform duties as assigned and are entitled to be  
4 paid at an hourly rate commensurate with the **daily rate** specified in  
5 subsection 1 ~~H~~, *as applicable, and are entitled to be compensated for*  
6 *overtime in the same manner as provided for employees of the legislative*  
7 *counsel bureau.*
