AN ACT relating to school police officers; extending the area of their jurisdiction; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

> THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. NRS 391.275 is hereby amended to read as follows:

391.275 The jurisdiction of each school police officer of a school district extends to all school property, buildings and facilities within the school district, and to the area within 1,000 feet of the perimeter of the grounds of each public school within the school district, for the purpose of:

1. Protecting school district personnel, pupils, or real or personal property; or

2. Cooperating with local law enforcement agencies in matters relating to personnel, pupils or real or personal property of the school district. **Sec. 2.** This act becomes effective on July 1, 2001.
