- SECTION 2. Amendments to these Bylaws affecting the mandated verbatim articles of the NEVADA ASSOCIATION OF INDEPENDENT TRAVEL AGENTS, LLC., shall be automatically adopted by the Board of Directors.
- SECTION 3. That annual changes to the NAITA Bylaws voted on by the membership be immediately authenticated at the membership meeting by the Bylaws Committee chairman, vice-chairman, all committee members and the Association Elected Vice President signing and initialing them. Copies with the above signatures on the first page and initials on each following page of the Bylaws are then distributed to the above signees.

ARTICLE XVIII - DISSOLUTION

SECTION 1. upon the dissolution or winding up of the affairs of this Association, the Board of Directors, after providing for the payment of all obligations, shall distribute any remaining assets to the NEVADA ASSOCIATION OF INDEPENDENT TRAVEL AGENTS, LLC., to be held in trust for a period of five (5) years. If a charter is granted by the Association for a new association in Nevada during the five year period, said remaining assets shall be distributed to the new association. If no charter is granted within the given year period, the NEVDAD ASSOCIATION OF INDEPENDENT TRAVEL AGENTS, LLC., shall distribute any remaining assets, within its discretion, to any other non-profit tax exempt organization.
