Proposed Amendment to Section 6 of AB 452:

- Sec. 6. NRS 637.090 is hereby amended to read as follows:
- 3-36 637.090 [A]
- 3-37 1. Except as otherwise provided in this section, a person shall
- 3-38 not engage in the practice of ophthalmic dispensing or manage a business engaged in ophthalmic dispensing without holding a valid,
- 340 active license issued as provided by this chapter.
- 2. A person may practice ophthalmic dispensing if:
- (a) He is enrolled as a student in a course of study for
 ophthalmic dispensing at a school which offers a degree of
 associate in applied science for studies in ophthalmic
 dispensing and is accredited by the Commission on Opticianry
 Accreditation;
- 41 (b) He practices ophthalmic dispensing under the direct
- supervision of a licensed dispensing optician, licensed optometrist or licensed ophthalmologist as part of the course of study described in paragraph (a); and
- 44 (c) The licensed dispensing optician, licensed optometrist or
 45 licensed ophthalmologist providing direct supervision pursuant
 40 this section is approved by the Board to provide such direct
 47 Supervision. The course of study described in paragraph (a) is approved by the Board for the purposes of this section.

Proposed Addition to AB 452:

Sec. 24. NRS 637.025 is hereby amended to read as follows:

Applicability. Nothing in this chapter shall be construed:

- 1. To apply to ophthalmic dispensing personally by a licensed physician, surgeon or optometrist unless exclusively engaged in the business of filling prescriptions.
- 2. To apply to ophthalmic dispensing by an employee of a licensed physician, surgeon or optometrist if the employee:

- (a) Practices ophthalmic dispensing only under the direct supervision of the licensed physician, surgeon or optometrist; and
- (b) While practicing ophthalmic dispensing, only acts to assist the licensed physician, surgeon or optometrist.
- 3. To apply to dispensing of prepackaged contact lenses by a licensed pharmacist pursuant to NRS 639.2825.
- [2] 4. To prohibit the sale of goggles, sun glasses, colored glasses or occupational protective eye devices not having a refractive value, or the sale as merchandise of complete ready-to-wear eyeglasses.
