AB 52 will award high school diplomas to World War II veterans that left high school to go to war. The program originated in the state of Massachusetts and was entitled "Operation Recognition". Wisconsin and many other states have similar programs.

During the 1940's, thousands of young men and women across the country left high school to serve bravely in the armed forces during World War II. Their sacrifice ensured our freedom, built our country into a superpower, and shaped the entire course of history throughout the world.
