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Safety First

1. The students on the bus are under the immediate supervision of the bus driver, and are thus subject to the rules set by the School Board and the State. A school bus is an expensive machine built to save you a long walk to and from school.
2. Students should not arrive at the bus stop earlier than 10 minutes prior to the departure of the bus.
3. Wait back off the street until the bus comes to a full stop. Form a single-file line.
4. Load quickly, quietly, and orderly.
5. Sit and remain seated while bus is in motion.
6. Act the same as in a classroom.
7. No unnecessary conversation with the driver when the bus is in motion.
8. Keep all parts of body inside the bus.

9. Keep your arms and legs out of the aisles.
10. No eating, drinking, or smoking on the bus.
11. No profanity or name-calling.
12. No loud conversation or other loud noises.
13. No singing, radio or cd players unless approved by the driver.
14. Take off the bus whatever you brought on.
15. Pupils wearing athletic footwear equipped with cleats or spikes not permitted on buses.
16. At your stop, remain in your seat until the bus has fully stopped, then go directly to the front exit door.
17. The driver is responsible for this bus at all times. Your cooperation will make your trip a success.
