

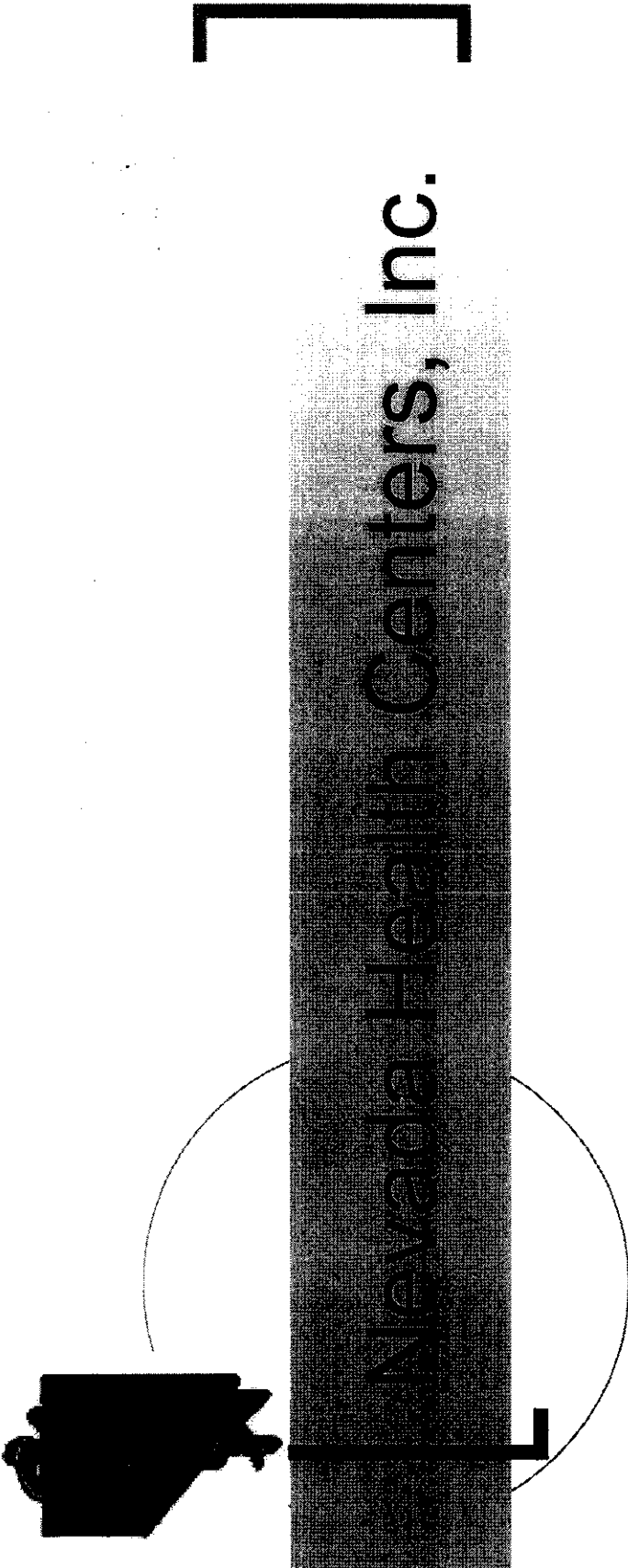

- *Nevada Health Centers, Inc. is founded on the principle that all people, regardless of where they live or their ability to pay, have the right to quality health care services.*

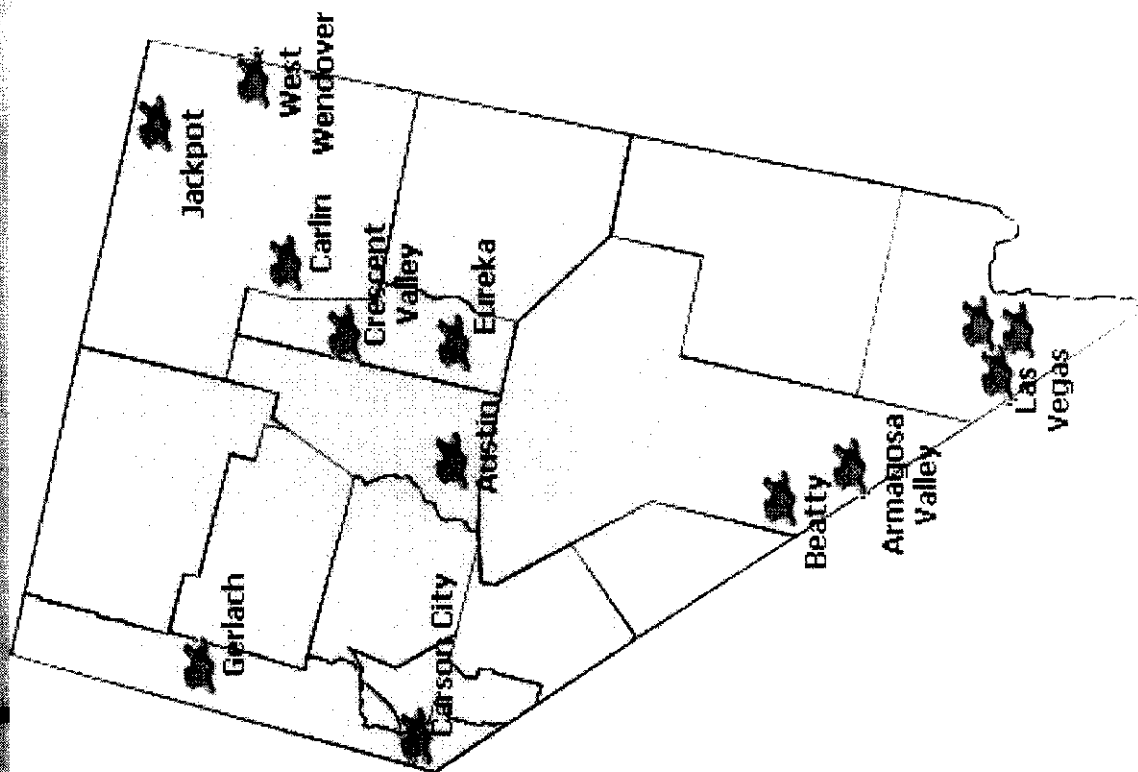


Who is Nevada Health Centers, Inc.?

- Founded in 1977 as a Public Entity
- In 1995, became 501 c 3 Private Non-profit
- NVHC is a Federally Qualified Health Center funded under Section 330 of the Public Health Service Act to provide for primary and preventive health care services in medically underserved areas.
- Governed by a 14 member Volunteer Board of Directors
- Two Administrative Sites-Carson City & Las Vegas
 - Billing, Finance, Quality Assurance, Human Resources, Operations, MIS and Special Programs.

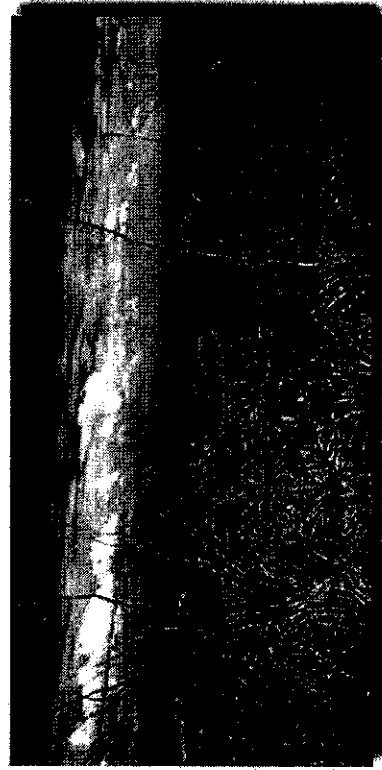

NVHC depends on a balanced distribution of funding sources.

- Currently NVHC's revenue comes from four main sources which include 47% patient charges, 30% federal grant, 23% local/county contributions, private contributions.





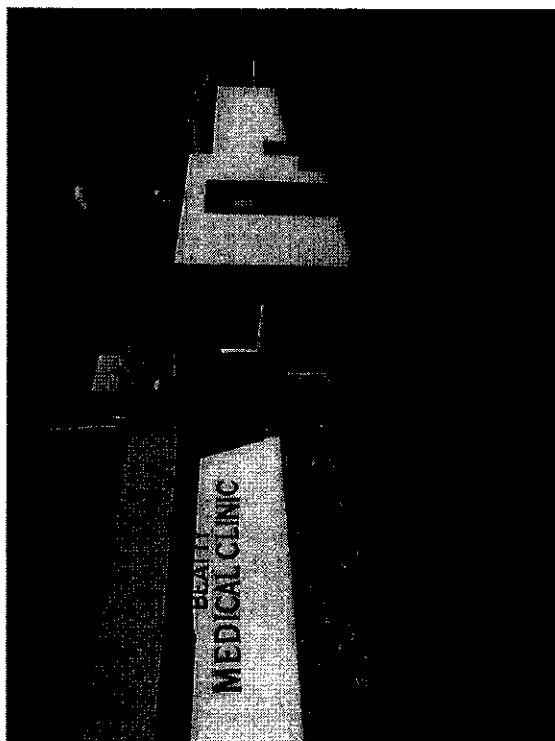
