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- Section 1. Chapter 200 of NRS is hereby amended by adding thereto the provisions set forth as sections 2 and 3 of this act.

- Section 4. NRS 200.030 is hereby amended to read as follows:
 - 1. Murder of the first degree is murder which is:
 - (a)-(d) [various murders which arise to the level of first degree]
 - Committed in the perpetration or attempted perpetration of an act of terrorism.
 - 2. ...
 - 6. As used in this section:
 - [Various definitions used in the section]
 - For purposes of NRS 200,030 and 200,033 only, "act of terrorism" (e) means:
 - 1. Any act of undeclared war against the United States of America: or
 - 2. Any act that involves the use or the threatened or attempted use of sabotage, fear or violence and is intended to:
 - (a) Injure, [i]ntimidate or coerce a civilian population; or
 - (b) Disrupt, affect or influence the conduct or policy of a governmental entity by intimidation or coercion; or
 - (c) Retaliate against a governmental entity or cause widespread panic or civil unrest through the substantial destruction, contamination, impairment or disruption of:
 - 1. Public or private buildings, infrastructure, communications, transportation, utilities or services; or
 - 2. Natural resources of the environment.
- Section 5. NRS 200.033 is hereby amended to read as follows:

The only circumstances by which murder of the first degree may be aggravated are:

- 1-14 [Various aggravators]
- The murder was committed with the intent to commit, cause, aid, further or 15. conceal an act of terrorism as defined in NRS 200.030.
