Dear Committee:

I am opposed with this bill that seeks to eliminate NRS 176.335(4) from the law. My mother was killed by a man who is serving a life sentence with the possibility of parole. See attached exhibit. This man comes up for parole in 2004. With NRS 176.335(4) in place as it stands now I can periodically review the criminal case file via the internet. Should this man die in prison, the Judgment of Conviction would be sent down to the County Clerk. I would then have full closure as to this issue and not have to rely on other sources for this information.

This is just one aspect of this law that is obviously very personal to me. Beside this aspect I believe the reporting required by NRS 176.335(4) is necessary from a due process standpoint and should not be eliminated. I will monitor the progress of this bill and would be very disappointed to see this bill passed.

Please do not add insult to injury to a real victim of crime by denying me certain access to the finality of this case. I should not have to depend on other agencies to give me this information with this statute in operation. I know too well how mistakes and omissions can occur from other agencies that would be required to report a demise of an inmate. This statute should not and must not be changed
