Current Law under Nevada Revised Statutes (NRS)	Sets forth public policy on smoking. Local agencies, boards, commissions, and political subdivisions prohibited from imposing more stringent restrictions on the smoking, use, sale, distribution, marketing, display or promotion of tobacco products than provided under NRS.	<u>Smoking prohibited in the following locations:</u> - Public elevator - Public building - Public waiting rooms, lobby, or hallway of medical facilities/offices - Hotels/motels, if designated by operator - Public area of stores devoted to sale of food for consumption off premises - Child care facility - Bus used by general public, other than chartered bus, or in any maintenance facility or office associated with a bus system operated by any regional transportation commission - School bus May designate separate areas used for smoking in all of the above locations except for public elevators, public buildings and school buses. Areas of grocery stores that are leased/operated for gaming cannot be so designated unless they qualify for an exemption under NRS 202.24915. <u>Public buildings</u> (includes schools) - Must designate a smoking area. <u>Restaurants with 50+ seating capacity</u> - must have nonsmoking area <u>Business with more than 50% gross receipts from gaming or sale of alcohol</u> - may designate entire business as a smoking area.	For stores principally devoted to sale of food for human consumption, smoking in a public area leased/operated for gaming is allowed if: - Entire public area of store is 10,000 feet or less; or - Area is segregated from other public areas by 2 or more walls or partial walls & uses ventilation to remove smoke from area. Until January 2010, stores constructed before October 1999 may allow smoking in public areas leased/operated for gaming. After January 2010, allowed only if area contains required ventilation. If these stores remodel 25% or more of public area before 2010, may allow smoking only if area contains required ventilation.	Cigarette vending machines are prohibited in public areas of the following, if minors are allowed access: - Public elevators; - Public waiting rooms, lobby, or hallway of medical facilities/offices; - Public area of stores devoted to sale of food for consumption off premises - Public areas of stores; - Child care facilities; - Buses used by the general public, other than chartered buses, and related facilities; - School buses
Assembly Bill 96	Prohibition deleted. Local board of health authorized to impose more stringent restrictions than provided under NRS.	Smoking not prohibited in "licensed gaming establishments" or legally designated smoking areas. List of locations in which smoking is prohibited is <u>expanded</u> to include: - Grounds of a public building within 100 feet of entrance or exit - All areas of medical facilities and offices - All areas of stores devoted to sale of food for consumption off premises - Chartered buses - Restaurants - School buildings or property - Malls containing retail establishments open to the public - Retail establishments open to public - Movie theatres - Video arcades Exceptions and authorization to designate smoking areas are <u>deleted</u> except smoking is <u>not prohibited</u> in "nonsmoking gaming establishments" (current law is "licensed gaming establishment" under current law) where smoking is authorized (other than a restaurant) or a business (other than a restaurant) that derives more than 50% of its gross receipts from the sale of alcoholic beverages on the premises. Schools may designate smoking area for employees that is outside of building and screened from pupils' view. - Child care facilities not authorized to designate smoking areas	N/A	Cigarette vending machines not allowed in public area of school to which minor has access
Assembly Bill 202	N/A	Removes references to language deleted under NRS 202.24915 (next column)	Authorizes store principally devoted to sale of food for human consumption off the premises to allow smoking only if: (a) Store is 10,000 feet or less (existing law); or (b) Area is <i>completely</i> segregated from other public areas of store. Also removes limited exceptions for stores constructed before 1999.	N/A
