
Dear Chairperson Anderson and Members of the Committee:

I would like to submit this letter as my written support for this Bill. I am the Director of TussCorp, a long-term care eligibility consultant and Medicaid planning and application specialist company. I believe that the changes as set forth in AB365 are an improvement to the guardianship statutes.

As the current statutes are written, there is no specific authority for the creation of and transfer of income and assets into special needs trusts, or income reduction trusts or "Miller Trusts." These items are needed to obtain Medicaid benefits for wards. I hope that you, as members of the Assembly Judiciary Committee, understand and see the need for these proposed changes and will assist in the passage of AB365.
