DUE TO THE UPCOMING "GUIDES LEGISLATION" I FEEL WE NEED TO SEND SOME DIRECTION TO THE AGENCY TO UPDATE THE POLICIES AND REGULATION IN THIS AREA.

I ALSO FEEL THAT A SUB-COMMITTEE WITH GUIDES AND COMMISSIONERS WOULD BE A USEFUL TOOL IN HEARING THE GUIDES CONCERNS, SETTING POLICIES AND REGULATIONS THAT COULD BE BENEFICIAL TO THE GUIDE INDUSTRY. I FEEL THAT THE AGENCY HAS IGNORED THEIR CONCERNS IN THE PAST.

I HAVE TALKED WITH SEVERAL GUIDES ABOUT THEIR CONCERNS AND HAVE WELCOMED THEM TO THE COMMISSION MEETINGS AS A GROUP OR INDIVIDUALS TO AIR THEIR COMPLAINTS.

NRS 504.390 ITEM 10, SAYS THE COMMISSION MAY ADOPT REGULATIONS COVERING THE CONDUCT AND OPERATION OF A GUIDE SERVICE. ALSO NRS 501.181 WHICH IS THE COMMISSIONS DUTIES AND REGULATIONS COVERS MANY AREAS OF THE GUIDING INDUSTRY, NON-RESIDENTS, AND LICENSING.
