### ACR / Conviderations

"The development of a broad-based tax structure that is reflective of the diversity of Nevada's economy is a desirable policy..."

### ACR I Considerations

- Identified a tax on sales or services for specific review
- Charged the Task Force to
  - "consider ways to reduce budgetary reliance on volatile or cyclical revenue streams."
  - "consider the desirability of lowering the state's sales and use taxes over time as new tax revenues become available"
  - "develop one or more definitive proposals to carry out the state's need to provide additional revenue for state programs, to stabilize the tax base and to reduce the long-term structural defect of the state budget.

### Tax on Services

- Taxes the larger, growing portion of the economy providing
  - Stability of revenue
  - -Breadth of tax base
  - Growth of tax base and tax revenue that matches economy and population
  - Predictability of revenue
  - -Insulation from Internet leakage

### Tas on Services

- Implementation as soon as January 1, 2004
  - Collection infrastructure already exists
- BRG recommends 5% on all taxable goods and services (not 3% suggested)

### Tax on Ferries

- Exemptions can include non-discretionary spending categories most households purchase yet
- Service tax base is larger than sales tax on products base
- Still provide hundreds of millions of dollars of new revenue

### Tay on Mervices at 5%

- $\approx$  \$400-500 million in new revenue
  - Educational enhancements or tax relief in other areas
- Tax Relief from Product Sales Tax
- © Economic Stimulus
  - Rate lower than surrounding states provides an incentive for purchases of goods and capital investment
