Amendment: Revises provisions relating to alcohol and drug abuse counselors (SB248)

Statement of Intent:

At the request of the Chief from the Bureau of Alcohol and Drug Abuse the Board of Examiners for Alcohol and Drug Abuse Counselors seeks authority to adopt regulations to certify detoxification technicians. When certification and licensure authority was transferred from the Bureau to the Board the responsibilities for certification of detoxification technicians was in-advertently not transferred.

Amendment to Sec.4.1, between lines 12 and 13

Add C. A Person who is certified as a detoxification technician. The verbiage for this section should be transferred from NAC458.189.1 & 2 and NAC458.194.2, which is follows:

A person who is certified as a detoxification technician may:

- 1. Perform detoxification screening pursuant to the standards established by the board; and
- 2. Present himself to the public as certified by the board as a detoxification technician.
- 3. A person certified by the board as a detoxification technician shall maintain current certification in cardiopulmonary resuscitation
- * "detoxification technician" amend NRS 641 sections as appropriate for continuity.

Amendment to Sec 12.1.b lines 17 and 18

Remove the following verbiage

_b. [or specialist in the prevention of substance abuse]
