2. The license issued by the state shall not display the address or any other personal information except the name of the holder of the license.

- 1 Sec. 2. NRS 644.360 is hereby amended to read as follows:
- 2 644.360 1. Every holder of a license issued by the Board to
- 3 operate a cosmetological establishment shall display the license in
- 4 plain view of members of the general public in the principal office
- 5 or place of business of the holder.
 - 2. The license issued by the state shall not display the address or any other personal information except the name of the holder of the license.
- 6 3. [The] Except as otherwise provided in subsection 3, the
- 7 operator of a cosmetological establishment shall lease space to or
- 8 employ only licensed manicurists, electrologists, aestheticians, hair
- 9 designers, demonstrators of cosmetics and cosmetologists at his
- 10 establishment to provide cosmetological services.
- 11 4. The operator of a cosmetological establishment may lease
- 12 space at his cosmetological establishment to a provider of health
- 13 care for the purpose of providing health care within the scope of
- 14 his practice. The provider of health care shall not use the leased
- 15 space to provide such health care at the same time a cosmetologist
- 16 uses that space to engage in the practice of cosmetology.
- 17 5. As used in this section, "provider of health care" means a
- 18 person who is licensed, certified or otherwise authorized by the
- 19 law of this state to administer health care in the ordinary course of
- 20 business or practice of a profession.
