What?

This budget has been revised since its initial preparation in July 2002

Why Revise?

□ To adjust estimated revenue

- Initial revenue estimates from the implementation of the Nevada Rural Courts System (NRCS) case management system were high

- The original budget anticipated a completed roll-out during the 2003 – 2005 biennium

Revised estimates indicate roll-out completion in FY2008

Why the Implementation Delay?

The administrative assessment shortfall resulted in staff reduction (contract services and AOC) due to cash limitations

Our pilot court implementation was complex and more time consuming than first anticipated, requiring more AOC staff assistance

System customization has been more varied and complex than anticipated
