SB 377 is too vague and could be detrimental to open space and wildlife including wild horses. The following information should be provided in detail in this act. My testimony is as follows:

- The number of acreage should be listed.
- The precise area for the fencing should be listed.
- It should state whether or not the fencing would be on public or private land.
- It should state the environmental impact.
- It should state whether or not it will impede the migration of wildlife and wild horses' access to water.
