## Talking Points SB 488 Senate Finance Committee Doug Bierman Humboldt River Basin Water Authority 4/2/03

- 1. There is a need for surface water storage capacity within the Humboldt River Basin.
- 2. The annual average flow of the Humboldt River is 296,000 ac.ft.
- 3. There are approximately 690,000 ac.ft. of decreed and permitted water rights within the entire Humboldt River Basin
- 4. Annual variations in flow produce economic and environmental uncertainty.
- 5. Additional surface water storage capacity would allow water to be stored during years of above-average flows and released during years of below-average flows.
- 6. The Humboldt River Basin Water Authority has evaluated options for managing above-average flows in the Basin.
- 7. The Authority believes that additional reservoir storage capacity and ground-water banking offer the greatest potential for the Humboldt River Basin.
- 8. Authority members have toured the Bishop Creek Dam site and agree with the need for the study envisioned by SB 488.
- 9. The Humboldt River Basin Water Authority encourages the Senate Finance Committee to provide the Legislative Committee on Public Lands with \$15,000 to study the feasibility of rehabilitating the Bishop Creek Dam.
