## ASSEMBLY BILL 315 (REQUESTED BY ASSEMBLYWOMAN KOIVISTO) HEARINGS 4/23/03 AND 5/2/03

Requires State Health Officer or person designated by Administrator of Health Division of Department of Human Resources to analyze information reported by health facilities concerning cancer to determine trends in incidence of cancer. (BDR 40-75)
