Senate Bill 91: Committee on Judiciary

Amendments submitted by Peter Krueger and Anthony Bandiero: Nevada Petroleum Marketers & Convenience Store Association

Change section 1, subsection 3, to read as follows:

Subsection 3

- 3. A person shall be deemed to be in compliance with the provisions of NRS 202.055(1) if, before he sells, distributes or offers to sell to another, alcohol, he:
- (a) Demands that the person present a valid driver's license or other written or documentary evidence which shows that the person is 21 years of age or older;
- (b) Is presented a valid driver's license or other written or documentary evidence which shows that the person is 21 years of age or older; and
- (c) Reasonably relies upon the driver's license or written or documentary evidence presented by the person.

Add new subsection 4 as follows:

Subsection 4

- 1. A person assisting in an inspection pursuant to this section shall, if questioned about his age, state his true age and that he is under 21 years of age.
- 2. If a person is assisting in an inspection pursuant to this section, the person supervising the inspection shall:
- (a) Refrain from altering or attempting to alter the person's appearance to make him appear to be 21 years of age or older.
- (b) Photograph the person immediately before the inspection is to occur and retain any photographs taken of the person pursuant to this paragraph.
