PROPOSED AMENDMENT SENATE BILL 317

Proposed by the University and Community College System of Nevada

SUMMARY - Makes various changes relating to incarcerated persons. (BDR 34-594)

- Amend Section 6, line 42, page 3, deleting "University of Nevada" and replacing it with "University and Community College System of Nevada."
- Amend Section 8, subsection 2(3), line 1, page 5 inserting the word "financial" before "eligibility criteria for federal need-based financial aid."
 - Insertion of the word "financial" is intended to clarify the specific type of eligibility criteria that incarcerated persons taking postsecondary courses will have to meet in order to qualify for "free tuition" under Nevada Revised Statutes (NRS) 396.540.
- Amend Section 8 by adding a new subsection 4 to NRS 396.540 with the following new language:
 - 4. In its discretion, the Board of Regents may waive the tuition and registration fees of any incarcerated person who is taking courses that lead to a postsecondary degree pursuant to section 3 of this act and who meet the financial eligibility criteria for federal need-based financial aid.

This change is intended to provide that incarcerated persons who are participating in the correction education program and meet the financial eligibility requirements for federal need-based financial aid may have their <u>tuition and registration fees waived</u>.
