SENATE COMMITTEE ON JUDICIARY

JUNE 2, 2003

The following measures may be considered for action during the work session:

ASSEMBLY BILL 460 (BDR 15-1283 was requested by Assembly Judiciary).

This bill makes various changes regarding manufacture, sale and use of tobacco products.

The bill was heard in Committee on June 2, 2003, and no Committee Action: action was taken.

Possible Amendments for Committee Consideration:

AMENDMENT ONE

Proposed by Michael Alonso -- to put provisions related to counterfeit manufacturers back in bill. This language was deleted from the First Reprint by Assembly Ways and Means, over concerns with the potential fiscal impact.

AMENDMENT TWO

Option One

TAB B Proposed by Shawn Gamble - to amend NRS 202.2491 to prohibit smoking of tobacco in video arcades, and to only allow smoking in certain public buildings, airports, convention centers or county jail, detention facility or correctional facilities if it meets ventilation and entrance requirements. amendment also redefines the definition of child care facility for purposes of prohibiting smoking, to a place where five or more children are provided care.

Option Two

Amendment proposed by Senate Judiciary - to adopt amendment as TAB C proposed above, but to delete Section 1.5(3) (portion related to public buildings, airports, convention center or county jail, detention facility or correctional facility).

Thus the Committee has the policy choice to either adopt TAB B or TAB C.
