- S.C.R. 13 Directs Legislative Commission to conduct interim study concerning economic, medical and societal costs and impacts of obesity in Nevada. (BDR R-25)
- S.C.R. 20 Directs Legislative Commission to conduct interim study of feasibility and desirability of changing state boundary line along border with Utah. (BDR R-786)
- S.C.R. 21 Directs Legislative Commission to conduct interim study concerning reconfiguration of school districts in this state. (BDR R-56)
