- 2-2 carrier may only cancel the policy upon 30 days' written notice to
- 2-3 the certificate holder and Administrator; and
- 2-4 (c) Contain such other provisions concerning notice as may be
- 2-5 required by law to be given to the certificate holder.
- 2-6 3. If an insurance policy is cancelled, the certificate holder
- 2-7 shall not operate or cause to be operated any taxicab that was
- 2-8 covered by the policy until other insurance is furnished.
