AN ACT making an appropriation to the University and Community College System of Nevada for use by the community colleges within the System to create and implement a Program of Workforce Development Challenge Grants; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN
SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1 **Section 1.** 1. There is hereby appropriated from the State
2 General Fund to the University and Community College System of
3 Nevada the sum of \$3,000,000 for the creation and implementation
4 of a Program of Workforce Development Challenge Grants by the
5 community colleges within the System.
6 2. The money appropriated by subsection 1 must be
7 distributed, in a manner determined by the University and
8 Community College System of Nevada, to the:
9 (a) Community College of Southern Nevada;
10 (b) Great Basin College;
11 (c) Truckee Meadows Community College; and
12 (d) Western Nevada Community College,

1 to create and implement a Program of Workforce Development
2 Challenge Grants. The Program must include the provision of
3 appropriate workforce training to ensure an adequate supply of
4 skilled workers to meet the demands of economic development.

5 **Sec. 2.** Any remaining balance of the appropriation made by
6 section 1 of this act must not be committed for expenditure after
7 June 30, 2005, and reverts to the State General Fund as soon as
8 possible.

9 **Sec. 3.** This act becomes effective on July 1, 2003.
