- 1 WHEREAS, Almost one-quarter of a million American men and
- 2 women are engaged in war with Iraq; and
- 3 WHEREAS, These members of our Armed Forces are exposed to
- 4 great danger and to the hazards and discomforts of the harshest of
- 5 climates; and
- 6 WHEREAS, They have forsaken home, family and friends in
- 7 obedience to the call of their country and fidelity to their oath of
- 8 service; and

1 WHEREAS, They undertake this duty and prepare to make the
2 ultimate sacrifice out of love for their country and the freedoms for
3 which it stands; and

4 WHEREAS, The men and women leave behind spouses, children
5 and parents who suffer great anxiety and make great sacrifices to
6 enable our servicemen and women to fulfill their patriotic
7 obligation; now, therefore, be it

8 RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, THE
9 SENATE CONCURRING, That the Nevada Legislature commends the
10 noble, selfless and heroic efforts of our American servicemen and
11 women; and be it further

12 RESOLVED, That the members of the Nevada Legislature join
13 with all Nevadans in laying aside debates about the prudence of the
14 cause in which our country is engaged and pray that this conflict
15 may speedily end and that these brave men and women may return
16 safely home to their families and friends; and be it further

17 RESOLVED, That the Chief Clerk of the Assembly prepare and
18 transmit a copy of this resolution to the Commanding Officers of all
19 military forces from Nevada currently serving in the war with Iraq,
20 including the Adjutant General of the Nevada National Guard, the
21 Commanding Officer of Nellis Air Force Base and the Commanding
22 Officer of the Fallon Naval Air Station.
