AN ACT relating to senior citizens; requiring the Aging Services Division of the Department of Human Resources to develop statistics to determine funding priorities and to publish a brochure containing the statistics; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN
SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1 **Section 1.** Within the limits of available money in the budget
2 of the Director of the Department of Human Resources, the Aging
3 Services Division of the Department of Human Resources shall
4 develop statistics to determine appropriate priorities for funding
5 programs for senior citizens and publish the statistics in a brochure
6 which must be entitled *Nevada Elder Count*.
7 **Sec. 2.** This act becomes effective upon passage and approval.
