SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION—Recognizing February 6, 2003, as Ronald Reagan Day.

- 1 WHEREAS, Former President Ronald Wilson Reagan, a man of
- 2 humble background, worked throughout his life to preserve freedom
- 3 and advance the public good, having been employed as an
- 4 entertainer, a Union leader, a corporate spokesman, the Governor of
- 5 California and the President of the United States; and
- 6 WHEREAS, Ronald Reagan served with honor and distinction for
- 7 two terms as the 40th President of the United States; and
- 8 WHEREAS, In 1981, when Ronald Reagan was inaugurated
- 9 President, he inherited a disillusioned nation shackled by rampant
- 10 inflation and high unemployment; and



1 WHEREAS, During his second election, Ronald Reagan earned
2 the confidence of three-fifths of the electorate and was victorious in
3 49 of the 50 states in the general election, a record unsurpassed in
4 the history of American presidential elections; and

5 WHEREAS, During Ronald Reagan's presidency, he worked in a
6 bipartisan manner to enact his bold agenda of restoring
7 accountability and common sense to government which led to an
8 unprecedented economic expansion and opportunity for millions of
9 Americans; and

10 WHEREAS, Ronald Reagan's commitment to America's Armed
11 Forces contributed to the restoration of pride in America, her values
12 and those cherished by the free world, and prepared the Armed
13 Forces of the United States to win the Gulf War; and

14 WHEREAS, Former President Reagan's vision of "peace through
15 strength" led to the end of the "Cold War" and the ultimate demise
16 of the Soviet Union, guaranteeing basic human rights for millions of
17 people; and

18 WHEREAS, After two terms in office, Ronald Reagan's
19 innovative and challenging program known as the "Reagan
20 Revolution," which focused on reinvigorating the American people
21 and reducing their reliance upon government, was considered a
22 complete success; and

23 WHEREAS, Today, February 6, 2003, Ronald Wilson Reagan
24 will have reached the age of 92 years; now, therefore, be it
