- 1 WHEREAS, The members of the Nevada State Legislature mourn
- 2 the loss of Marvin Carr who passed away on September 17, 2002;
- 3 and
- 4 WHEREAS, Marvin Carr was born in Salida, Colorado, to
- 5 Chester and Irene McCollum Carr; and
- 6 WHEREAS, Marvin Carr graduated from Smith Valley High
- 7 School and served in the United States Army National Guard for 9
- 8 years; and
- 9 WHEREAS, Nancy Wines and Marvin Carr were married in
- 10 Smith Valley on July 17, 1955; and



1 WHEREAS, A Yerington resident for 41 years, Marvin Carr was
2 a dedicated firefighter who served the residents of the State of
3 Nevada in various capacities during his career in fire service
4 spanning over 40 years; and

5 WHEREAS, After beginning as a volunteer firefighter for Lyon
6 County in 1955, Marvin Carr chose fire fighting as his profession,
7 serving much of his career with the Mason Valley Fire Protection
8 District and the Central Lyon County Fire Protection District; and

9 WHEREAS, Marvin Carr was appointed Lyon County Fire
10 Marshal in 1971, where his responsibilities included blueprint
11 checks for public buildings, fire investigation, and inspections for
12 conformance with fire and uniform building codes; and

13 WHEREAS, In 1986 Marvin Carr was appointed Fire Chief for
14 the newly formed Central Lyon County Fire Protection District; and

15 WHEREAS, Marvin Carr was named as the Director of Lyon
16 County's Emergency Management Division in 1991 and as the
17 Executive Director of the State Emergency Response Commission
18 in 1996; and

19 WHEREAS, In 1998 Marvin Carr was appointed as the State Fire
20 Marshal, the head of the State Fire Marshal Division of the
21 Department of Public Safety for the State of Nevada; and

22 WHEREAS, Marvin Carr also served as past president and was a
23 life member of the Nevada State Firefighters Association, a member
24 of the Nevada Fire Chiefs Association and the Nevada Emergency
25 Preparedness Association and, in 1997, was selected to the
26 International "Who's Who" of Professionals Representing the Fire
27 Service; and

28 WHEREAS, Marvin Carr is survived by his wife Nancy, sons
29 Gene and Steven, brother Bill Young, mother Irene, stepfather
30 C. W. Hamilton and three grandchildren; now, therefore, be it

31 RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, THE
32 ASSEMBLY CONCURRING, That the members of the 72nd Session of
33 the Nevada Legislature extend their sincere condolences to the
34 family and friends of Marvin Carr; and be it further
