Chairwoman Buckley requested Committee introduction of BDR 32-390 and BDR 32-392.

- BDR 32-390: Authorizes the Department of Taxation to require the payment of outstanding liabilities and delinquencies before issuing a new license or permit or reactivating an old license or permit. (Assembly Bill 68)

- BDR 32-392: Allows for the revocation or suspension of a state business license for failure to comply with statutes or regulations. (Assembly Bill 67)
