MINUTES OF THE SENATE COMMITTEE ON TAXATION

Seventy-third Session April 21, 2005

The Senate Committee on Taxation was called to order by Chair Mike McGinness at 11:45 a.m. on Thursday, April 21, 2005, on the Senate Floor of the Legislative Building, Carson City, Nevada. There was no Agenda. There was no Attendance Roster.

Chair McGinness indicated to the Committee that its proposed amendment to <u>Senate Bill 481</u>, which changed the word "less" to "more," would transfer all the county optional tax revenue and the State tax revenue to the Civil Air Patrol. He indicated the impact of the change may have exceeded the intent of the Senate Taxation Committee.

SENATE BILL 481: Makes various changes relating to Civil Air Patrol. (BDR 32-1348)

Chair McGinness suggested changing the previously adopted amendment to delete the proposed change of "less" to "more," but retain the other proposed changes. He said the \$130,000 cap would be removed also, which would result in the same distribution: optional tax revenues would be remitted to the

counties that impose them, the rest would go to the Civil Air Patrol. The Committee's intent was to remove the cap, which this would accomplish.

SENATOR TOWNSEND MOVED TO FURTHER AMEND <u>S.B. 481</u> TO REFLECT THE PROPOSED CHANGES AS DISCUSSED.

SENATOR COFFIN SECONDED THE MOTION.

THE MOTION CARRIED. (SENATOR TIFFANY WAS ABSENT FOR THE VOTE.)

Chair McGinness adjourned the floor meeting at 11:58 a.m.
