Chair Nolan called a meeting on the Senate Floor for the purpose of introducing nine bill draft requests (BDRs).

- <u>BILL DRAFT REQUEST 43-219</u>: Prohibits Department of Motor Vehicles under certain circumstances from renewing registration of motor vehicle if court has filed notice of nonpayment of certain outstanding criminal fines and fees with Department. (Later introduced as Senate Bill 474.)
- <u>BILL DRAFT REQUEST 43-403</u>: Revises provisions relating to mounting of flashing amber warning lights on certain vehicles. (Later introduced as <u>Senate Bill 468</u>.)

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- <u>BILL DRAFT REQUEST 35-1047</u>: Authorizes use of interest earned on money in State Highway Fund to match federal money for rural transit operations in certain counties. (Later introduced as Senate Bill 469.)
- <u>BILL DRAFT REQUEST 32-1081</u>: Limits liability of certain private operators who contract with regional transportation commission. (Later introduced as Senate Bill 475.)
- BILL DRAFT REQUEST 32-1301: Makes certain changes relating to tax on special fuels and registration of motor vehicles powered by electrical power or alternative fuel. (Later introduced as Senate Bill 476.)
- BILL DRAFT REQUEST 43-1338: Revises provisions concerning penalties for failure to secure child in approved child restraint system. (Later introduced as Senate Bill 472.)
- BILL DRAFT REQUEST 43-1339: Authorizes emergency lights to be mounted and displayed on certain privately owned vehicles under certain circumstances. (Later introduced as Senate Bill 471.)
- <u>BILL DRAFT REQUEST 44-1340</u>: Provides for regulation of pedestrian traffic in airports. (Later introduced as Senate Bill 470.)
- <u>BILL DRAFT REQUEST 43-1370</u>: Expands authority of governmental entity and agent thereof to use certain equipment to gather evidence for issuance of traffic citation. (Later introduced as Senate Bill 473.)

SENATOR AMODEI MOVED TO INTRODUCE <u>BDR 43-219</u>, <u>BDR 43-403</u>, <u>BDR 35-1047</u>, <u>BDR 32-1081</u>, <u>BDR 32-1301</u>, <u>BDR 43-1338</u>, BDR 43-1339, BDR 44-1340 and BDR 43-1370.
