

ASSEMBLY BILL NO. 101—COMMITTEE ON WAYS AND MEANS

**SUMMARY**—Makes appropriation to Department of Administration for allocation to Nevada Commission for National and Community Service. (BDR S-1213)

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AN ACT making an appropriation to the Department of Administration for allocation to the Nevada Commission for National and Community Service to match federal funding for continuation of its programs dedicated to promoting citizen volunteerism; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1       **Section 1.** 1. There is hereby appropriated from the State  
2 General Fund to the Department of Administration the sum of  
3 \$365,000 for allocation to the Nevada Commission for National and  
4 Community Service to match federal funding for continuation of its  
5 programs dedicated to promoting citizen volunteerism.

6       2. Upon acceptance of the money appropriated by subsection 1,  
7 the Nevada Commission for National and Community Service  
8 agrees to:

9       (a) Prepare and transmit a report to the Interim Finance  
10 Committee on or before December 15, 2006, that describes each  
11 expenditure made from the money appropriated by subsection 1

1 from the date on which the money was received by the Nevada  
2 Commission for National and Community Service through  
3 December 1, 2006; and

4       (b) Upon request of the Legislative Commission, make available  
5 to the Legislative Auditor any books, accounts, claims, reports,  
6 vouchers or other records of information, confidential or otherwise  
7 and irrespective of their form or location, which the Legislative  
8 Auditor deems necessary to conduct any audit of the use of the  
9 money appropriated pursuant to subsection 1.

10     **Sec. 2.** Any remaining balance of the appropriation made by  
11 section 1 of this act must not be committed for expenditure after  
12 June 30, 2007, and must be reverted to the State General Fund on or  
13 before September 21, 2007.

14     **Sec. 3.** This act becomes effective upon passage and approval.

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
