

ASSEMBLY BILL NO. 103—COMMITTEE ON WAYS AND MEANS

(ON BEHALF OF THE DEPARTMENT OF ADMINISTRATION)

**SUMMARY**—Makes appropriation to Department of Administration for allocation to Nevada Rural Hospital Partners for establishment of pool for loans and grants for rural health care providers. (BDR S-1216)

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AN ACT making an appropriation to the Department of Administration for allocation to the Nevada Rural Hospital Partners for establishment of a pool for loans and grants for rural health care providers; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1       **Section 1.** 1. There is hereby appropriated from the State  
2 General Fund to the Department of Administration the sum of  
3 \$1,000,000 for allocation to the Nevada Rural Hospital Partners for  
4 establishment of a pool for loans and grants for rural health care  
5 providers.

6       2. Upon acceptance of the money appropriated by subsection 1,  
7 the Nevada Rural Hospital Partners agrees to:

8       (a) Prepare and transmit a report to the Interim Finance  
9 Committee on or before December 15, 2006, that describes each  
10 expenditure made from the money appropriated by subsection 1  
11 from the date on which the money was received by the Nevada  
12 Rural Hospital Partners through December 1, 2006; and



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1       (b) Upon request of the Legislative Commission, make available  
2 to the Legislative Auditor any books, accounts, claims, reports,  
3 vouchers or other records of information, confidential or otherwise  
4 and irrespective of their form or location, which the Legislative  
5 Auditor deems necessary to conduct any audit of the use of the  
6 money appropriated pursuant to subsection 1.

7       **Sec. 2.** Any remaining balance of the appropriation made by  
8 section 1 of this act must not be committed for expenditure after  
9 June 30, 2007, and must be reverted to the State General Fund on or  
10 before September 21, 2007.

11      **Sec. 3.** This act becomes effective upon passage and approval.

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
